Dear members,

Following consultation with the Society's National Medical Director around the continued provision of Skin Camouflage Service. The following advice has been recommended to maintain proper infection control procedures reducing risks to members and the public.

- Follow general HSE advice.
- **Do not provide** any services if feeling symptomatic.
- **Do not provide** any services if returned from one of the listed regions.
- Respect the right of service users to decline an offer of service.
- Wear clean volunteer attire when providing each service.
- Change into clean clothes and maintain hygiene standards following service provision.
- Ensure any non-disposable items used during service provision are cleaned before and after use.
- Regularly clean mobile phone devices, where possible do not take out mobile phone device during service provision.
- Contact skin camouflage client's 24 hours prior to scheduled appointment to confirm they are showing no COVID-19 symptoms as outlined on Public Health advice leaflet attached to this email.

I would ask that members remain vigilant and be aware of any local risks which may impact on service provision. Our priority is to reduce risk to members and safeguard service users.

As further information becomes available you will continue to be advised of relevant updates. For now matters have not reached the point where escalation to a stage where the principal response agency (HSE) have advised the suspension of any services. The situation is being closely monitored by staff in head office.
