Irish Red Cross volunteers in Donegal are currently meeting with those who have been impacted by the tragedy in Creeslough to provide immediate humanitarian assistance along with meeting and listening to community and faith leaders.

A member of the IRC staff team will be in Creeslough Pharmacy back office every Thursday during the day and a Volunteer in Creeslough Community Centre each Wednesday evening from 7.30 pm to 9.30 pm and Sunday from 11 am to 2 pm in November.

The Irish Red Cross have also begun a listening and consultation process with those impacted by the event and with other agencies providing assistance currently. Once this consultation is completed an agreed process will be in place to enable those affected by the tragedy to receive structured support.

The next meeting with the Irish Red Cross and the Creeslough Community will take place on Thursday, 24th November in the Community Centre in Creeslough starting at 7 pm.
