The Government in collaboration with local authorities has launched a new call for offers of unoccupied houses, apartments and holiday homes to provide accommodation for Ukrainian people fleeing the war.

For people who wish to pledge shared accommodation (a room or rooms within an occupied property)

If you wish to pledge shared accommodation, the Irish Red Cross is continuing to process shared pledges already received and welcomes additional new shared pledges which will be processed from 15 December 2022 at <https://registerofpledges.redcross.ie/>

Information to Note

The Government has stated its intention to make the required legal changes to increase the accommodation payment from €400 to €800 per month. Pledges to the new local authority unoccupied homes call, shared pledges to the Irish Red Cross or private pledges can attract this support if they meet the criteria as stated on www.gov.ie
