The SRC is supporting the Ukrainian Red Cross Society (URCS) in its humanitarian response in Ukraine. To assess, develop and contribute to health-related strategic planning and project development, the SRC is seeking a Health Delegate **starting 1st October 2023 or as per mutual agreement** to be based in Ivano-Frankivsk, Ukraine. **Travel to other regions of Ukraine will be required.**

What you will be doing

- Support URCS branches with strategic development and implementation of health projects, in particular in health for the elderly/disabled and psycho-social support (PSS), in close coordination with the URCS headquarters and other Red Cross partners in country
- Develop modalities for integrating health (including home-based care and PSS) in shelter and other thematic programs
- Ensure community participation in assessments, planning, implementation and monitoring and assure technical quality of the projects and coherence with national and technical standards
- Initiate project implementation through close accompaniment to URCS and set up the M&E system and contribute to project proposals and produce accurate, regular and timely narrative and financial reports
- Participate in Technical Working Groups, Cluster Meetings and other relevant forums
- Closely coordinate with the URCS, clusters, the affected communities, the Ukrainian government, different RC/RC actors, UN agencies, international/national NGOs and Swiss NGOs

- Oversee the capacity enhancement on health programming of URCS health staff and volunteers, through training, on-the-job coaching and mentoring
- Support the Delegation's Crisis Management Group (GMG) to ensure adequate health care/measures for SRC staff in Ukraine

- Education in a health-related field and/or public health and at least 5 years of working experience in the domain of community health or public health
- Minimum 3 years of proven experience in the coordination and management of health programs, ideally including community-based health projects
- Minimum 3 years of proven experience in leading a team
- Demonstrated experience with localization and capacity building of national/local partners
- Analytical and strategic planning skills (Project Cycle Management)
- Experience in writing project proposals and reports
- Very good written and spoken English is essential (working language), knowledge of Ukrainian/Russian language would be an asset
- Experience in working with the Red Cross/Red Crescent Movement is an asset.
